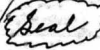
DATE OF BILL, PROCESS, &c.

I therefore appoint Harriet Devan my mother and my wife Nancy Brown to carry into effect this my will and testament but in case either of the appointed guardians should act contrary to this my directions then the said person who acting thus contrary to the above to resign their trust and appointment In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twelfth day of July 1821
