 the God do this fourth day June 1801
 Make and Publish this my last will
 and Testament in Manner following
 that is to say—
 First I give and bequest unto my Son
 James Conway all that part of my Land
 on the North Side of Lick Creek,
 I give & bequest to my son Christopher
 Conway One Hundred and Thirty Acres
 of Land Beginning at The mouth of Lick
 Creek running up the river one
 Hundred ^{and} ^{more} above the fields cleared By
 Jesse Evans running a straight course
 from the river and bounded by
 Lick Creek to include the com-
 plement the aforesaid, I give & bequest
 to my son William Conway a tract of
 parcel of land whereon I now
 live beginning on the river of Mr.
 Hugh Nelson line running toward
 said river to the said land already
 given to Christopher Conway then
 running along Christopher Conway line
 so far as to take one half of my
 land not before mentioned, I give &
 bequest to my son Henry Conway
 the remaining part of my land beginning
 below white's Ford where the line
 crosses Lick Creek running a
 South course to the upper corner
 so as to include the remainder
 part of my land not before
 mentioned. I desire it that
