First I give and bequeath unto my dearly beloved wife Nancy one good bed, the half of the kitchen furniture and the half of the house hold furniture -

After my decease all my land and all my loose property is to be sold at publick value and the money to be equally divided between Elizabeth Goble the daughter of Magdaline Keece and my wife Nancy and my daughter Rachel my son Adam and my son Gabriel

I likewise constitute, make and ordain the sole Executor of this my last will and Testament my beloved and trusty friends Dorned Noble and John Cook and I do hereby utterly, disallow, revoke and disannul all and every other former Testaments, wills, Legacies, Bequests and Executances by me in anywise before named, witnessed and witnessed, ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this fifth day of September in the year of our Lord, 1821.
