State of Tennessee Hawkins County, in the name of God Amen, I Anna Leonard, being of sound mind & memory & considering the uncertainty of this frail & transitory life do hereby declare & Ordain this to be my last will & Testament, (and first I commend my Spirit to God who gave it, and my body to the dust from whence it came)

Second - I wish ^{all} my just debts and Funeral Expenses paid, with my personal property, and my real Estate I give and bequeath as follows. To my daughters Susannah & Patricia Leonard, I give Fifty-two Acres of the East end of my farm including my dwelling with all the appurtenances thereon, I my daughter Mary I bequeath twenty four Acres of the South west corner of my farm adjoining the lands of C. Leonard, and the remainder of my lands I give to my son Elijah and his nearest blood relatives and their assigns forever, and should there fail to be a Son in his part of the land, my will is that he shall have a right to vote when it may suit his convenience &c, &c.

Fourth - I give & bequeath to my daughter Sally Bony, thirty five dollars, to be paid to her by Rebecca Leonard,

Fifth - I give & bequeath to Rebecca Leonard & her heirs as the dower of her Mother, the farm above named, with all the house hold & Kitchen stuff, & farming utensils with all other things appertaining thereto, except such as was her before named.

The last will and Testament of Jane B. Armstrong dec'd. Given April Term 1857,

I Jane B. Armstrong of Hawkins County, Tennessee being of sound disposing and memory do make publish & declare the following to be my last will and Testament,

First - It my will and desire that out of the first moneys that may come into the hands of my Executor hereafter named, my funeral expenses and my just debts should be paid,

Secondly - It my will and desire, and I do bequeath all my estate, or property whether it consist in money, real, lands or any other kind of property whatever or whether it be in my possession or in the possession of any other person for me to my three Sisters to wit Mary M. Sarah Ann, and Elvira Armstrong, to be equally divided between them, Shan and Shan alike, and if either of them should not survive me then and in that case it is my will and I do direct that my real estate should be divided between the survivors and if but one Sister should be living at the time of my death, then she should have all my estate and if none of my said Sisters survive me, then I wish and bequeath all my estate to my Mother James G. Armstrong absolutely.

Lastly - I do hereby appoint my said Brother James G. Armstrong my Executor of this my last will and Testament.
