

Will of Malinda Bradley

State of Tennessee

Hawkins County

I Malinda Bradley of Said County and State, being of sound mind but Old in years, and knowing that life is uncertain and death is sure, do hereby make this my last Will and testament.

1st I bequeath to my daughter Hager Chesnut wife of Edward Chesnut, the House & Lot upon which I now reside in the town of Rogersville, Said house & lot having been formerly owned by H. G. Kyle, Said Hager to have the Complete Control of Said Property during her life but at her death, it is my will that it go to her children if she may have any.

2nd I desire that my burial expenses be paid out of the money on hand & on deposit in the Rogersville Bank, & that a suitable Tombstone be paid for out of Said funds to mark my last resting place.

3rd I will and bequeath unto my daughter Hager all of the Personal Property I die possessed of including the money to my credit in the Rogersville Bank, but it is my specific request that Said money at my death shall go in to the hands of my Executors and that they are to hold it in ready cash and not to hazard it by loaning it, and I release them from the payment of interest upon it, but I do not want them to have any compensation for their services, and in the event my daughter Hager may desire that they may pay her any sum not to exceed five dollars for months business in case of live business.

4th I will that in the event my daughter Hager dies without heirs, that is to say heirs of her body, then all of Said property real and personal shall go to my other children or their legal representatives in equal proportion, I hereby name and appoint Samuel Hill & W. L. Kerner my Executors.

Will of Daniel Hamblen

In the Name of God Amen,

I Daniel Hamblen of the County of Hawkins & State of Tennessee, being of Sound and disposing Memory, I hereby make this as my last Will and testament, that is that after paying all my just debts, I will and bequeath and give to my brother William Hamblen all my real and personal property of any description consisting of one undivided half interest in the tract of land on which we now reside containing of about one hundred and sixty acres -

Also one half interest in the Chesnut tract across the Creek and adjoining the home place, and containing about forty five acres.

Also one half interest in horses, and all other personal property of all kind, I hereby constitute and appoint the Said William Hamblen as the executor of this my last will and testament.

It is my desire that Said William Hamblen as such executor shall not be required to give bond with security in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 15th day of June 1886
