

The Last Will and Testament of Alexander Long of Hawkins County Tennessee.

I, Alexander Long of Hawkins County Tennessee, do make and publish my last will and testament, as follows:

- I. I will and direct that all my just debts be paid by my executors hereinafter named out of my money I may have at my death, or out of the proceeds of such personal property as they may elect to sell.
- II. I will and give to my son John W. Long a good horse to be selected by him out of any I may have at the time of my death.
- III. All the remainder of my personal estate I give to my wife Eliza A. Long and my son Robert A. Long to be divided equally between them.
- IV. I also will and devise to my said wife Eliza A. Long and to my said son Robert A. Long, the tract of land upon which I live on Ganey Creek in the 11th Civil district of said County adjoining the lands of Samuel Webb, William Pease, James Emmitt and John Carter and containing 33 acres more or less, to have and to hold the same as tenants in common equal estates or interests therein.
- V. I leave, advanced my other children such portions of my estate as I intended them to have, and do not therefore wish to make any further provision for them out of my property.
- VI. I nominate and appoint my sons John W. Long and Robert A. Long as executors of this my last will and testament.

The Last Will and Testament of William Snider.

I, William Snider being in feeble but of sound mind and memory do make this my last will and Testament.

First I give my sister Angeline Snider of all of my personal property after all just debts are paid I do give the above named sister a certain tract of land lying in Hawkins County Tennessee and in Dist. No. 11 lying on the North side of Poor Valley Creek and the South side of Clinch Mountain and adjoining the lands of S. W. Price and others beginning on a Pine tree on the Poor Valley Creek then a West course with S. W. Price line to opposite the Still house branch then a North course with said branch to the top of Clinch Mountain then East with top of Clinch Mountain to Mary Ann Howard's line then South with her line to a chestnut oak corner known as the Henry Brooke and Mary Ann Howard and Angeline Snider corner then a West course to the first branch then a South course with said branch to a spring known as the Isaac Snider Spring then a South East course with Angeline Snider's line to the beginning corner.

I give my sister Mary Ann Howard wife of William P. Howard all of the balance of the land that I own now the land mentioned in this will was willed to me by my father Isaac Snider and in his will he boun't me to pay 2 heirs of Sterling Vaughan and Sally Daughan their heirs. Their names are Charles Daughan and Nancy Daughan the sum of Sixty Four Dollars now in this will I bind my sister Angeline Snider to pay the sum of Forty Nine Dollars of the above Sixty Four Dollars I also bind my sister Mary Ann Howard wife of William P. Howard to pay Fifteen Dollars to the above named heirs when they arrive at the age of twenty one years the 1st of August 1889.
