I also will that my son Thomas W. Tynes, retain as a part of his ^{above named} dividend the Negro girl Nancy, now in his possession and should the said Negro girl Nancy have a child or children it is my will that said increase shall not be considered as my estate.

I hereby nominate & appoint as my Executors my sons Benj^r Tynes, Thomas W. Tynes and Anthony Carlton
