SAMUEL HENDERSON, M.D., of Williamson County, Tennessee; was *b.* 8th October, 1804; *d.* 9th December, 1884; graduate of Jefferson College, Philadelphia; was a Mason and became a Knight Templar in 1850; *m.* 14th March, 1844, Rachel Jane Martin HUGHES, *b.* 27th February, 1818, *d.* 16th June, 1858, dau. of Capt. John and Sally (MARTIN) HUGHES and gd. dau of Col. Archelaus HUGHES of Patrick County, Virginia, who commanded a Virginia Regiment during the Revolutionary War, the son of Alexander HUGHES, the son of Orlando HUGHES of Wales, *m.* 16th February, 1769, Mary DALTON, *b.* 1748, *d.* 1841, dau. of Samuel DALTON of Rockingham County, North Carolina.
