Paris Township Henry County July 26th 1836

The following is a transcript of the return of the commissioners appointed by the Legislature for the division of the County in districts for Magistrates & Constables.

We the undersigned commissioners for the County of Henry appointed by the General Assembly to lay off the said County in justices of the peace & Constables districts met according to the act of Assembly and laid them off in the following manner viz

District 1st - Beginning at the Court House in the town of Paris running West 100 poles including Wm R Harris North 260 poles including Edmund Stephens East 320 poles including Hugh Dunlap Esq. & Saml Pearce South 260 poles including Isaac Mc Campbell it being the bounds of the extended Corporation of said Town - the place of holding elections in the Court house
