In the name of God, amen, I, James Howard, Widder, of the County of Henry and State of Tennessee, being old, but in good health of body and sound in mind, do hereby make and constitute this my last will and Testament (to wit)

I leave to my son, John B. Howard, during his life time and give and bequeath to his son, William Bernard Howard, the following negroes (to wit) my negro woman, Eliza or Lizzy, now about forty years of age with all the children which she may hereafter have, and also my negro girl Betty, said Lizzy, daughters now in possession of said John B. Howard and all the children which she may have and also Elizabeth a negro girl, and Henry, negro boy, children of my negro woman, Mary and grand children of said Lizzy, by said Mary and all the children said Elizabeth may have, and should the said William Bernard Howard, die without children, said negroes are then to belong, and are hereby given and bequeathed to the other lawful heirs of the body of said John B. Howard, which he may hereafter have; and should the said John B. Howard die without leaving any children, said negroes above are then to belong, and are in that case given and bequeathed to Angelina and Clementine, daughters of my son James B. Howard, save and except said negro girl Betty, who in that case is to belong, and is given and bequeathed to Martha S. Howard, wife of said John B. Howard should she survive him.

I leave to my son William B. Howard, during his life time and give and bequeath to his daughter Jane Elizabeth Howard, my said negro woman Mary (daughter of said Lizzy) and her two children, Francis, negro girl, and Robson, negro boy, and all the children which said Mary and Francis may have hereafter, and should said Jane Elizabeth die without children, they are then to belong and are in that case willed and bequeathed to the then lawful heirs of the

body of said William H Howard, which he may hereafter have, and should he die without any such heirs or children, said negroes are then to belong and are in that case willed and bequeathed to my grand daughter Jane B Pope, daughter of my daughter Sarah S Pope, deceased, and should said Jane B Pope die without children, they are then to belong and are in that case willed and bequeathed then to said Angelina and Clementine, daughters of said James H Howard.

I also will and bequeath to my son Almon H Howard one bed and furniture to my daughter Mary H Howard one bed and furniture to my granddaughter Angelina Howard daughter of my son James H Howard one bed and furniture to my granddaughter Jane Elizabeth Howard, daughter of my son William H Howard one bed and furniture to my son Thomas A Howard two beds and furniture.

I also give and bequeath to my sons James H Howard and Thomas Howard all my stock of every description and kind, horses cattle sheep, hogs &c all my fowls of every kind all my household and kitchen furniture and all the property I now own on the plantation on which I now reside, not herein given and bequeathed. The farming utensils are reserved as belonging to my son, said Thomas A Howard.

It is also my will and request that the liquidation of any debts that may come against me which are lawful and just, said negroes as above specified and described shall be reserved as the last property to be sold and all my other property as above specified and described shall be first to be sold, and that if said negroes said Betty shall be reserved
