Item 1st - after my decease it is my desire that my mortal body be hurried in a decent Christian like manner, and all the just debts which I may be owing at my death to be first discharged or paid out of the effects of my estate.

Item 2nd. I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Katherine McMan one good riding horse, or mare, one feather bed to be inherited after the death of myself and said wife and not before and I furthermore give and bequeath to my said daughter Katherine McMan and my beloved daughter Elizabeth Wallace conjointly together and separately my girl of colour Caroline and any increase which may hereafter arise from the said girl for and during the lives of my two aforesaid daughters and after the death of either one of my said daughters mentioned in this fifth item the said girl and any increase which may arise from the said girl to be equally divided between the lawful heirs of their bodies but the said property not to be inherited by either or any of them until after the death of both myself and my said wife.
