TRANSCRIPT OF A MINUTE IN THE OLD CHURCH BOOK

March 5th 1922. The session met after the 11 O'clock service Elders present H. S. Holleman, Guy Maddux, Peyton Grisham and T. D. Hargis, Van E. Smith moderator. H. S. Holleman was appointed to attend Presbytery at Cookeville April 12, 1922 and Elder Guy Maddux his alternate.

The session voted to confer with Cumberland Presbyterians on building a union Church and appointed J. M. Williamson to confer with said members.

In accordance with the above resolution ruling Elder J. M. Williamson hold conferences from time with the members of the Cumberland Church on the proposition to build a union Church. The old building having been damaged by a heavy storm and otherwise in bad repair, the need of a new house of worship was emphasized by all parts.

The most generous overtures were made by Elder Williamss, to the Cum-Berland Church Committe with a view to building a union Church, the Conference continuing all the summer of 1922 without a decision being reached by the committee representing the Cumberland Priestyterian Church, so the matter ended and a congregational meeting of Granville Presbyterian Church U. S. A. was called to meet on Sert. 3, 1928 at 3 Colock in the afternoon.

Following is a transcript of the minute of the meeting Held on Sunday Sect. 3rd. 1922.

Session met at eturch at 3 C'clock P.". with Elder Grisham, Hollsman, Guy Maddux, J. M. Williamson, T. J. Harris and others members of the Church. It was voted by all present to build a new Church on other lot end a building Committee composed of J. M. Milliamson, Chairman. A. B. Harris, Guy Maddux, H. S. Holleman & T. P. Harris were appointed to select a lot take subscriptions and to arrange about said building Van P. Smith presided at the session.

In Obedience to the action set out in the foreroing minute of Sept. 3rd, 1922. The committe proceeded to obtain subscriptions and convass for a suitable building lot. The Committee work with diligence, energy and real as did the members of the congregation. Sufficient funds were raised innediately and the committee proceeded to purchase the material having the greater part of it at the rail read in less than three weeks time.

Early in October more than thirty wagons and motor trucks hauled the material from Baxter, Term. to Granville. This was volunteer cooperative and an expression of enterest on the part of all in the new Church enterprise.

Mrs. Elizabeth M. Har s widow of J. M. Harris Dec'd (who was far more than 50 years a ruling Elder in the Church) being desirous to aid largely in building a new Church and also in memory of her beloved husband made a gift to the Church of a building lot and on October the 11th 1922 the corner stone was laid with appropriate ceremonies conducted by the pastor.

The building Committee secured the service of a. B. Harris and Wyme Askew as mechanical foremen, the work progressed with interest and speed and much of the credit for the heautiful new house is due to the loyal efforts of the women of the compregation.

A Board of Trustees composed of Ruling Elders J. M. Willimson, C. W. Maddux, Guy Maddux, Henry Holleman, John Wat s, T. D. Hargis and W. P. Grisham proceeded to organize and sincerporate the Granville Presysterian Church U. S. A. under the laws of Tennosses.

Smith Sabbath School Musichary of the presbytery and a short historacle account of the origin and growth of the Church was given by the pastor Nev. Van 1, Smith.

The above is a verbatum transcript of an old Church Record, and tentered on the Kinutes of This New Church Record by the present Pastor Rev. Van. M. Smith of Cordonsville, Tenn. a member of Cumberland Mountain Presbytery and who has been preaching to the Granville Presbytery Church U. S. A. from 1917 to the present date.

This transcript made on this the 8th day of April 1924.

The Granville Prosbyterian Church, U. S. A. Corner stone was laid-Oct. 12, 1922 by 200. Van Smith.

This Church was dedicated June 1, 1924 by Sev. Van Smith and Dr. Willer.
