Where as Garrett D. Sadler and James D. McKinley, having been appointed by the Session of Elders of Sparta Presbytery to sell the lot of land known as the "Smyrna Camp Ground Lot" and in presence thereof, do with the advice, and consent of said Elders, to wit:-

A. A. Duke, Hugh E. Smith, Thos. C. McKinley, M. T. McDonald, J. M. Williamson, John Mitchel, Nelson Carter, Henry Sadler, and James Hargis here by sell and transfer to S. K. McDonald and M. T. McDonald and their heirs and assigns forever for the consideration of One Hundred Dollars cash paid. Said Smyrna Lot lying in Jackson County, Tennessee, about one mile south of Granville and bounded entirely by the lands of Mrs. Jane Holloman with the following calls to wit:- Beginning at a Box Elder on the bank of the river, about 1 rod from low water mark, that said lot may be more definitely located, and running thence up the river 4 rods, 1 rod above the mouth of branch to a stake; thence North  $78^{\circ}$  W. 12 rods to a stake; thence North  $86^{\circ}$  - 42 rods to said Smyrna Lot to a stone set for a corner; Thence North 6 rods to a stone; Thence North  $82^{\circ}$  E. -  $9\frac{1}{2}$  rods to a stone; set for a corner; on the West side of the Granville Road; Thence South  $46^{\circ}$  E. - 23 rods to a stone above the Road; Thence South  $56^{\circ}$  - W. 20 rods to a point where a stone fence crosses W small draw; thence North  $37^{\circ}$  W. 22 rods to a stone on the Shepherd line south  $51^{\circ}$  W. 3 rods about from the beginning property; Thence with said Shepherd line to the beginning containing Exclusive of this neck on road to the river, Three acres, nearly in said road to river the public has an interest in common with said lot, there is also a right of way to and from the Spring near Mrs. Jane Holloman Home for the use and benefit of said lot which right of way is included in this sale. To have and to hold the same to the said S. K. and M. T. McDonald, their heirs and assigns forever.

We covenant that we are lawfully seized of said lot, That the same is unincumbered and that we have a good right to convey it: We further covenant and bind ourselves to warrant and defend the Title to the foregoing described Lot, and its privileges to the said S. K. and M. T. McDonald, against the lawful claims of all persons whom so ever.
