

Andrew Chamberlain X

The last will and testament of Andrew Chamberlain how departed this life the 11th day of February 1793 is as follows his desire was that after his brother Jeremiah Chamberlain had gotter his part of the land on Ritchland his own part that remains he desired that it should be equally divided in six parts a gruable to quantity and suitable to each Jeremiah John Mary Margaret Elisabeth and Janet and it was his desire that his father James Chamberlain should have ten shillings, only he desired that Anne and Janet Chamberlain daughters of John Chamberlain should have each of them have two and eight and that James Chamberlain should have a gruable to each of Jeremiah Chamberlain daughters Mary Janet and it was his desire that Owen Brown should have ten pounds and five pounds to Levi Taylor if he stayed, and if Levi Taylor dont stay then he desired that Owen Brown should get a Fifteen pounds more. And it was his desire that that Bond he had on James Mcbery should be divided equally between Jeremiah, Mary, Margaret Elisabeth and Janet and he desired that his two brothers Jeremiah & John Chamberlain should have his cloathing equally divided between them and that cloth that James Mcbery is to be sold and divided between my four sisters this 9th day of February 1793

follows his desire was that after his brother Jeremiah
Chamberlain had got his part of the land on Dutchland
his own part that remains he desired that it should be
equally divided in six parts a great little quantity and
his little sister Jeremiah John Mary Margaret Eliza-
beth and Janet and it was his desire that his father
James Chamberlain should have his share, only he desired
that Mary and Janet Chamberlain daughters of John Cham-
berlain should each of them have a cow and a calf, and
that James Chamberlain son of John Chamberlain should
have a quartering calf, and a cow and a calf to each of Jer-
emiah Chamberlain Mary Margaret Janet and Elizabeth
his little sister that each should have ten pounds, and five
pounds to Lewis Taylor if he stayed, and if Lewis Taylor
dont stay, then he desires that Mrs. Brumit should get a
Fifteen pounds more. And it was his desire that that
Bond he had on James Melchior should be divided equally
between Jeremiah, Mary, Margaret Elizabeth and Janet
and he desires that his two brothers Jeremiah & John Cham-
berlain should have his cloathing equally divided between them
and that cloth that is left is to be sold and divided between
my four sisters this 9th day of February 1793
