In the name of God Amen, I Daniel Rupell of the
State of Tennessee Jefferson County being in perfect
health and of perfect mind and memory thank
be given unto God, calling unto mind the mor-
tality of my body and knowing it is appointed once
for all men to die do make and ordain this my last
Will and Testament that is to say principally and
first of all I give and recommend my Soul unto
the Almighty God that give it and (and) my
body I recommend to the Earth to be buried at the dis-
cretion of my Executors not doubting but I may
receive the same again at the General Resurrection
by the mighty Power of God and as touching
my worldly Estate I give and demise and
dispose of the same in the following manner and
form. First I give and bequeath to my beloved
Wife Semimah Rupell all the Household fur-
niture and one bay Mare and her choice of two
of the Cows to dispose of at her death as she
pleases. Likewise I lend to my Wife the plan-
tation that I live on during her life and two
Negroes named Jack and Darks likewise
the Negro Man named Jack is to be
given

262) Given to my son Joseph Russell after
his death. Likewise the Negro Woman named
Dart is to be given to my Daughter Betsey Welch
after the death of my Wife Jerimiah Russell

Secondly I lend to my Daughter Sarah Burdian the plantation that she lives on Beginning at Trotters line at a forked Sycamore on the Creek thence down the Creek to Trotters line and from that to the Beginning Likewise I lend to said Sarah One Negro man named Low the Land and Negro I lend to her while she lives so long Land and Negro is not to be traided or in any wise put out of her hands as long as she lives and same land and negro at said Sarah Burdian death is to be equally de vided amongst what children she has to James Burdian Likewise I give to my Daughter Mary Atchley one Negro woman named Turner, and one Negro boy named Harvey and one Negro Child named Looky Likewise I give to my Daughter Seminah the Land that Sew lives on Beginning at the new Road Running to the Beginning Concluding all that part of Land and one One Negro boy named Sam Likewise I give to my Daughter Ellis McMahan One Negro Man named Frank and one Negro boy named Sam

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boy named Lam Likewise I give to my
Daughter Ollis McMahan One Negro Man
named Frank and one Negro boy named
George. Likewise I give to my Son Amos
Russell the Land that I live on as was
mentioned before at his Mothers death
and one Negro Man named Jack and

and one Negro Girl named Diny 263
Likewise I give to my Daughter Rachel Rogers
one Negro Woman named Hager, and likewise
Joseph Burdian and Ellis Mc Mahon and Joseph
Rupell is to pay them ettother at the rate of
five pounds per year as long as Shew lives to help
to maintain Her. Likewise all my stock of
all kindz that is not mentioned is to be equaled
divided and all the rest of my property that
is not mentioned is to be Equally divided
amongst all my Children that is each an equal
Share.

I likewise do appoint and or
dain Semimah Rupell my beloved Wife my
Sole Executrix ^{with my son Joseph Rupell}
and William Mc Mahon whom I also appoint
and ordain with my Executrix to be my sole
Executors in this my last Will and Testament
And I do hereby utterly disallow, revoke and
disannul all and every other former Testa
ments, Wills and Executors by me in any
wise before Willed or bequeathed Ratifying
and Confirming this and no other to be
my last Will and Testament In wit
ness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and Seal this 14th day of September in the year
of our Lord 1805.
