fifteenth day of February the year one
thousand eight hundred and ten publish
this my last will and Testament in manner
as following that is to say - I first give and

body to return to the dust I give and bequeath
to my wife Ruth all the movable property I
now possessed of also the house and plantation
I now live on untill my son John is of age
then he shall have the one half of the land
and my wife Ruth the other half of the
land and the buildings during her natural
life and at her decease the plantation to
fall to my son John also I give and
bequeath to my wife Ruth the gouse of
all the negroes, Jan, Mose, Ned and Nance
during her life tho not permitted her
nor no other person to bargain or sell
or make a way this negroes out of the
family nor there in free and at her
decease the negroes and there in free if
any shall be equally divided between my
seven children John Jency Ruth Meli-
dash and my Polly Betsy and the above

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movable property at his decease to be disposed
of as she thinks proper among my Children
I hereby make and ordain my wife Ruth
and Brother David Executors to this my
Last will and Testament in witness
whereof I hereunto set my hand and
seal the day and year above written
