perfect mind and memory (blessed be God) Do, this
twelfth day of March, in the year of our Lord, One thou-
sand eight hundred and four, Write and publish this my
last will and testament, in manner and form following
that is to say. First I give and Bequeath unto son in law
John Hill fifty Acres of Land off of the Tract I now
live on. Beginning on the Bank French Broad River

At Parmenas Taylors corner, and extending across the bottom along said Taylors line opposite to the mouth of the first stream that next to John Hill, then up the stream to the road then along the road so as to include the said John Hills houses and improvements, and from thence to the river to include fifty Acres.

Secondly, I give and bequeath unto my beloved son John Mann all the rest of my Land & Estate and farming tools of every kind whatever with one horse and a saddle to be put into his possession at his coming of full age by my Executors, untill which time the rents and profits on the said lands shall be for the common support of my wife and the family. And if he should decease before he comes to full age, or before he has heirs of his own then the said rents and property shall be sold and equally divide amongst all his Sisters shares and their heirs.

Thirdly, I give unto my Daughters Sarah and Mary each of them one horse saddle bridle and bed at their Marriage or sooner if necessary. — It is also ^{will and} my desire that my Negro Woman Nance be equal divided amongst all my Children, that is, it is my desire that one of my Children shall take her, which she most desires to live with, and pay to the rest their proportionable part.

I also give and bequeath unto my beloved wife all the rest of my Estate of every kind whatever during her
