Will and Testament. in the first place it is
my desire that all my lawful debts should
be paid out of my personal property and
the rest to be devise my loving wife Ruthy to
have the speck mare and the mooly cows and
her heffer and a calf and for my loving daug
hter Sinthy to have the bold mare and colt
two cows and a calf and one yearling and for
my loving son Joseph to have the big mare
and young horse and cow and calf and one
heffer seven sheep to my wife and seven to
my daughter Sinthy and son Joseph my
daughter Sintha to have one cow and three
sheats and for my loving daughter Susanna
to have one cow and calf as for my house
furniture my loving wife to have two beds
and covers and Sinthy and Joseph to have
three beds and covers and for my loving son
David to have the big bittle and a small
oven and for Sinthy to have the big pot
and the little oven and for my wife Ruthy

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to have the big oven and the little pot
 what on the arifer to be equally divided
 between Ruthy and Sinthy Sinthy to have a
 certain track of land lying between where
 I now live and Cairns to corner fifty yards
 down from the new field and run across
 the wagon road and turn up the hollow
 towards Cairns and the old track to be equally
 divided between my wife Ruthy and Sinthy
 and Joseph what money is due me after
 my debts is paid to be divided equally
 between Ruthy my wife and Sinthy and
