Last Will and Testament of Benjamin H Green D^ed

In the Name of God Amen I Benjamin H Green of the county of Lauderdale and State of Tennessee being of a sound mind and memory, and considering the uncertainty of this frail & transitory life, do therefore make Ordain Publish & declare this to be my last Will & Testament, That is to say, First, after all my lawful Debts are paid & discharged the Residue of my Estate Real & Personal, I Give and Bequeath and dispose of as follows.

To wit. To my son George Rowland Green I Will & Bequeath all of my Estate Real & Personal, viz my Tract of Land containing One hundred and twenty five acres Being ~~adjoining~~ lying in District Third Lauderdale County State of Tennessee, also my Household & Farming Utensils. Then Beds, & Bed clothing for the same, Two Bed Steads, also one 3 year old Bay Horse, & one sorrel colt 2 years old, also Two hundred dollars Placed in the Hands of Mr. Albert M. Huston for the purpose of being invested by him in Tennessee, which he will account for to my Executor. There is also the amount of thirty five hundred Dollars in Gold & Silver coins in three several Despoils which I think best to be known only by a few faithful Friends and now in case my son George die previous to his Lawful Majority, then the Estate I wish to be divided Equally between his own uncles, and aunts and if any of them should die, then portion shall be given to their children. It is furthermore my wish that my son George be kept at school sufficient to procure a good English Education. I therefore make, constitute and appoint my Father in Law Rev Robert Gregory to be Executor of this my last will and Testament hereby Revoking all Former Wills by me made.
