and it is my will that the d. Agnes
Adams shall have the possession of the above bequest
during life and at her death they shall revert to my
daughter Sarah Adams and farther it is my
will that all the land which I hold in the State
of South Carolina lying in Chester District on
Rocky Creek should be sold and all my lawful
debts paid out of the money arising from the sale
of d. land and the balance of d. money to be
divided between my wife Agnes Adams & my
daughter Sarah Adams the former having two
parts & the latter one and it is my will that my
executors as any of them herein after named should
sell d. land & make legal titles to the same
and farther I will and bequeath to my beloved nephew
Abraham Adams my silver watch & silver mo-
unted riding whip and farther I do hereby
constitute & appoint my beloved wife Agnes
Adams my sole executrix and my beloved friends
Richard Myat & Samuel Little my sole Executors
of this my last will & testament committing my
Estate & family to their management & guardian-
ship and hereby disannulling all other wills &
testaments made by me and confirming and
ratifying this as my last will exclusive of all others
