

I do give to all my Daughters above mentioned, a negro a piece of equal value and then the whole of all my personal Estate property to be equally divided, between all my Children namely Nancy, Charles, Martha, Malinda, Hiram, Susan John, and Mary Morgan, I do give to my Son John Morgan his part of the Land that will take the plantation which now live on

An abridgement to my will Testament
If my wife Mary Morgan Deceases before my two young Children comes of age the use of all my negroes, plantation and Stock, and house hold furniture and farming tools as before mentioned, is to be for the use of raising & schooling of my ^{two} Children John, and Mary Morgan and then to be divided, as aforesaid in the will, I do leave my wife, and Son Charles Morgan, & Saml Bright, executor

of signing sealing Publishing and declaring the same of sound mind & memory whereupon came Saml Bright and Mary Morgan; the Executor and CoExecutor; thavins named & entered into bonds approved of by the Court & qualified to act
