Isaac Conger & Henry Pybas qualified to act as
executors to said will & gave bond with approp-

soul unto the hands of god who gave it & as touching
such worldly estate where with it hath pleased god
to bless me in this life I give & dispose of the

manner following first I positively will & order
that all my lawfull debts be paid second I will
& order that all my property be ^{share} equally
divided amongst all my children excepting my two
negro boys Adam & Jos I will & order them to
Wm White & Robert M. White at my death & appoin-
ment of Wm White & Robert M. White as my executors & do hereby
make & confirm this my last testament in witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal
this 9th day of July 1813.
