In pursuance of the order, we whose names hereunto annexed being a jury appointed to lay off and a sett to Henry Hurley, his right of survivor of the real and personal property of said Hurley deceased and third of the land beginning at a bench, the beginning corner of sd Hurley's tract of 400 one hundred & 45th acres and running east 62 poles to the beeches on the bank of a branch, then north 133th poles to a sugar tree, hornbeam & head in a hollow thence west, sixty two poles to a stake, thence south to the beginning including part of the improvement, spring and all the buildings that said Hurley died ^{possessed} of and of the personal property of three negroes to wit Do & Biddy & Frederick by paying to Elizabeth M. Hurley, Sally Buchanan & others, Hurley heir of said Joseph Hurley, ninety dollars, twelve months from the date, In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and affixed our seals the 15th October 1820.
