Children and all the balance of my Estate I give to my beloved Father Edw? Saturn after paying all my last debts also debts title and appraisals my Father Edw? Saturn my executor to all the my Estate and pay off the above mentioned Legacies & Debts. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my ^{and} hand and seal to be set the twenty & second day October one thousand eight hundred and twenty
