now give the same to be his last
will & testament & that he was
at that time of sound mind &
memory.

John Warren and Will

Know all men by these presents that I
John Warren of the County of Lincoln State
of Tennessee for my perfect benefit and
in hopes of a happy immortality testifying
that my reputation is now at hand to
depart from my earthly possessions in the
manner following to wit I have bequeathed
to my dear children which I have lived for
many years and other children born in number
than I have before. Girls which I have and
more bequeathed on her body and my mind
to this property of every description to be dis-
posed of in the following manner, I wish
the said Warren to be educated out of any money
or property I may die possessed of after pay-
ing all my debts and to the residue of my
property to be equally divided between her
the said Warren & each of her children
& that Henry Warren & Willis Warren be
appointed executors to dispose of my property
agreeably to the above will & so declare
this my last will revoking all others in
testimony whereof I have hereunto set
my hand & seal this 12th day of June 1820
