In the name of God amen whereas
I Thomas Young of the State of Minnesota
Lincoln County Being in a very low state of
health but in perfect mind and memory and
calling to mind the mortality of my body and
knowing it is appointed for all men to die do
make and ordain this my last will and Testament
in manner and form following that is to say
principally and first of all I recommend
my soul to the hands of God Almighty

That gave it and my body I recommend to
the earth to be decently interred at the discretion
of my heirs and executors and touching such real
estate as it hath pleased God to bless me with
I will and bequeath that all my
principally and first of all I will that all my
debts and funeral charges be paid and secondly
I will and bequeath that my beloved wife Mary
Young whom I make and ordain one of my Execu-
tors of this my last will and Testament to have
and to hold, during her life or widowhood and
have the liberty of buying and selling any part of
my property for to discharge debts or for the use of
my family except my land and several horse
Saddles and bridles and all my working tools
with a Iron furniture and one cow and calf
which I will and bequeath to my son Daniel Young
whom I make and ordain as my Executor
of this my last will and Testament at the
marriage or decease of his mother and thirdly I
will and bequeath to my four daughters that
now lives with me one feather bed and furniture
and cow and calf to each and fourthly and
last of all I will and bequeath the remainder
of my property to my nine children William
Young whom I make and ordain my Executor
Elizabeth Beard Mary Beard Semima Young
Sally Young Marjary Young Nancy Young
Vanice Young Thandy N Young to be equally
divided amongst them all at the marriage or

hereby disallow twists and disannul all my former
will or wills by me in any wise before named
written or bequeathed Ratifying this and no other to
be my last will and testament in witness whereof
I have set my hand and affixed my seal this eight
eenth day of February in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred and thirteen in presence
of Woodson Haley &

This last will and testament of Thomas Young
Deceased was exhibited to probate whereupon came
Woodson Haley and Alexander the subscribing
witnesses thereto and made oath that they saw
Thomas Young sign seal publish and declare this
to be his last will and testament and that
he was at the time of signing sealing &
publishing the same of sound mind and memory
to the best of their skill and ability let it be
entered on the will Book at full length

In the name of God Amen
I Andrew Buchanan being sick and weak of body
but of sound mind & disposing memory for which
I thank God, & falling to mind the uncertainty of

Human life & being anxious to dispose of all such
valuable substance as it hath pleased God to bless
me with that is to say 1. I give and bequeath to wife
Gerritt one third part of all my land and it is to be
considered that it is in dispute if last she is to have
my Negro boy named Daniel so long as she remain
in widow hood then to be the property of my son Lea-
den Buchanan & she is to have the disposal of
all my household furniture for to raise my children
with and as much of my personal property as my
executors can sufficient for to school & raise them
with the remainder to be sold. 2. I give and bequeath
to my son Leaden Buchanan the remainder of my
land and it is to be considered he is to have all the land
at her death if the land is gained if not to have the
Negro likewise my executors to let him have a horse if
he should live to raise the family and stay with them
3. When my personally property is sold I wish my
executors to collect my debts that will be due and
pay my debts and give my daughters which is
Sinthy & Lovrey Grinsey Betsey & Peggy all
Buchanans an equal part of all the money
that remains of the sale of my personal property
and it is to be considered that my Negro boy named
Daniel if the land is not last he is to be divided
amongst all my children Last I appoint
Samuel Buchanan my Brother & John B.
Buchanan executors of this my last will
