William B. Grippan Will

In the name of God Amen
I, William B. Grippan of the County of
Lincoln State of Tennessee, Being now
sick and in a low condition as to state of
health but of sound mind & memory
do now attain constitute and make
this my last Will & Testament in wri-
ting and making void and annulling all former
wills if any should be produced and
bequeath I leave my estate in the
following manner to wit, ^{first} I allow my body for to be buried
and funeral expenses paid
Secondly I bequeath and leave unto Oliver
Grippan & Diannah Grippan my father
and Mother my lands on the waters of
Cypress Creek in Lauderdale County
Alabama Territory on the north side
of Tennessee River containing one
quarter Section & a half quarter Section
on their leaving to said lands one
of the office, and at their death
for to be equally divided among my
Brothers and Sisters or their children
here after named, Wiley Grippan, Eaten
Grippan Henry Grippan Benjamin Grippan
Edward Grippan Polly Clark

Elizabeth Thompson and to the children
of Sally Abel,

thunderly, I allow all of my personal
estate or property for to be sold by
my Executors on a twelve months
credit and all of my last debts
for to be paid and the balance run
running for to be equally divided among
my ~~brothers~~ above Brothers sisters &
Sisters children as a above named

I do now constitute nominate and
appoint my two brothers Eaton Grierson
and Benjamin Grierson my whole sole
executors of this my last will & testament
Signed sealed & delivered in the presence of
this 23rd January 1819
