to him and his heirs forever. Third I give to my son
William Reed twelve and a half cents to him and his heirs
forever. fourthly I give to my daughter Elizabeth Reed
twelve and a half cents to her and her heirs forever.
Fifthly I give to my son James Reed twelve and a half cents
to him and his heirs forever. Sixthly my wife and desire
is that at my death, that my land shall be sold on
a twelve months prettie and the money arising from
such sale to be equally divided between my wife
Elizabeth Reed and my son Benjamin Reed my
son Nathaniel Reed my son Lemuel Reed my
son Abner Reed and my daughter Hanny Reed
and Polly Reed. Also I give to my son Abner Reed
one Baylors coat claimed by him. Also give to
my daughter Polly Reed one chest bed and furniture
claimed by her. Also give to my wife Elizabeth Reed
one bed and furniture claimed by her. Also is
my wife and desire that my children that is Mary
with me at my death and take care of me and
my stock together with my plantation tools to be
equally divided among such children. Also the
remaining part of my household and kitchen
furniture, But should one of these my last named

My children die without lawful heirs then his or her
share to be equally divided among the survivors lastly
named, and my will and desire is that Nathaniel
Reed and William Edwards execute this my last will

my sister Leahy Dodson one feather bed to wit
the best with my mother when I left Virginia
also I give and bequeath to my brother James
Dodson all my right and title to a certain
tract of land lying in granville County North
Carolina claimed by my father Thomas Edwards
deceased. I also constitute, ordain & appoint Matthew
Dodson my wife Leahy and the help of my son
Leahy Dodson, County Virginia my executors to execute
all things according to this my last will and Testament
as the law directs.
