her 800 lbs of pork 125 lbs salt 15 lbs
coffee 30 lbs sugar 15 bushels wheat 860
barrels corn 14 sides leather & the cotton
same rough flax & two little Cows -
Witness our hands this 10th November 1818 -

Allowance to Mr. Tatton Deed Whison
made by the Commissioners appointed by
the County Court of Lincoln, for that purpose
which is as follows -

We the under signers have met at the house
of William Tatton Deed, and have allotted for
the support of the widow & children for
twelve months; One barrel of Corn five pounds
weight of Pork, Two hundred weight of red Cotton
now in hand, and one hundred Dollars for
to purchase sugar coffee &c.
