My desire is that all my children share equal in the proceeds of my property both of the sale and what is coming from my Father's estate except the bed & furniture above named which I give to my daughter Susan Catharine one and above what I give to the boys & I do hereby appoint my brother Mark Whitaker guardian to my four sons Francis Marion, Patrick, Henry Mark, & William and that he take charge of them and what is coming to them and he is authorized to bind them out to learn trade, or to such persons as he in his discretion may think proper, and my will is that he be not required to give security as guardian.

and my will is that my sister Luda & Pruit be and is hereby requested to take charge of my daughter and care & school my daughter Susan Catharine, and call on my executor for funds as she may require.

My will is that my Bro. Benjamin J. Whitaker be and he is requested to be my Executor and that he be not required to give security. Signa scilicet and delivered in the presence of day and date above written.
