First I will and bequeath John W. Glegom have fifty

to be in the hills. Secondly I will and bequeath that  
the balance of the Lands be equally divided between the  
balance of my children Betsy Jane Hugh Mary Elender  
Martha Minerva Sarah Susan Rebecca Rushula Elvira

Thirdly I will that Elvira's share be laid off so as to include  
the dwelling and spring also I will that the resident be  
occupied by the family as a resident until the becomes of  
age. Fourthly I will and direct that if the executors think  
proper at any time with the consent of all the children  
they may sell the Lands belonging Betsy Jane Hugh  
Mary Elender Martha Minerva Sarah Susan Rebecca  
Rushula Elvira. Fifthly I will and direct that if the Lands  
be sold a guardian or guardians be chosen or appointed  
as the age of the child may be to take care of the proceeds  
said Guardian bound as the court may direct.

Sixthly I will that if the Lands belonging to Betsy  
Jane Hugh Mary Elender Martha Minerva Sarah  
Susan Rebecca Rushula Elvira be not sold that they be  
partitioned and divided and that each child draw its share  
at it comes of age. Seventhly I will and direct that  
the open Lands be rented until sold or the children  
becomes of age and that the rent be appropriated to the  
support and educating the Children by Executors  
Eighthly I will John W. Glegom have his horse and  
Saddle and Betsy Jane have the new side Saddle  
and Hugh my saddle. Ninthly I will that John W.  
and Betsy Jane have a Beasthead for each and his  
and clothing and the balance of the house hold

furniture to the balance of the family the  
present Crop and Stock to be appropriated to  
the use and benefit of the family and that after  
my just debts are paid John W. have fifty dollars  
if there be that much and if there be any more it  
be applied to the support of the family  
Lastly I ordain and appoint John Matt and William  
A. Gault Executors to this my last will and testament  
in testimony whereof I have set my hand and seal the  
August the 17<sup>th</sup> the year of our Lord One thousand
