

2^d. I have and bequeath to my children, named as follows, John, Carolina, Lewis, Carroll, Malvina, William Farlow and James Fletcher the remainder of all my real and personal estate and to be divided equally amongst them as they come of age and in case of the death of any of the above named children before they come of age, then and in that case the part or share thereof pertaining to be equally divided among the remainder.

3^d. I have and bequeath to my daughter Lavinia Blair (otherwise) McKeown so much as shall be of value sufficient to make up the said Lavinia's part or share so as to amount to the same of any of the others above named after the deduction of one hundred and fifty dollars as taken out of the same and making it on her an equal to any of the rest and said amount that is coming to said Lavinia's part to be paid as soon as all or the whole of the money may be collected of said estate or so soon as there is sufficient funds collected to discharge the same.

And lastly I nominate and appoint my friends William Barrow and George McKeown executors of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all others or former wills or testaments by me hitherto made. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 13th day of Sept 1827. Malcolm McKeown

James Randal's will.

I James Randal being sound in mind and conscious of my approaching end, being weak in body, having first committed my soul to God, do thus make and constitute this my last will and testament.

First It is my will that after my business has been properly settled and wound up by the persons and in the manner hereafter appointed the property that may then be remaining in the hands of my Executors be given to my mother Catherine Randall of Down Patrick Donegal Ireland and that she be my heir; and have the whole of my property exclusively.

Second It is my will that Robert Dickson and John P. McConnell of the town of Haythorpe County of Lincoln & State of Tennessee be my executors to this my last will & testament to effect a settlement with my partner in business James Mullard and be clothed with full power and authority to settle and wind up my estate.

George Heath's Will.

Memorandum. That I George Heath of the State of Tennessee and Lincoln County being in my perfect senses and right mind; and contemplating that it is appointed for all men once to die. I do make this my last will & testament on the words following.

N.B. First of all being in respect of the rights of man being entitled to freedom I do as an act of Justice of humanity emancipate & set free from

my decease and at my wife's decease and do
hereby emancipate the said Sally from my heirs
executors administrators or assigns from all sla-
very forever Item I give and bequeath to my
wife the place that I now live on; and all the
property that is left her lifetime; and after her
decease I want what property will be left equally
divided among my children. And do appoint
my two sons Nathaniel P. Heath, and Amos
C Heath executors of this my last will and tes-
tament revoking and disannulling all other wills
testaments, or covenants debiring this and only
this to be my last will testament and no other.

James Cheatham's Last Will.

In the name of God amen

I James Cheatham of the County of Lincoln State of Ten-
nessee, being of sound mind & memory, calling to
mind the mortality of my body, and knowing that it is
appointed for all men once to die, do make, ordain
publish & declare the following to be my last will and
testament in writing, towed.

1st I recommend my soul to God who governs,
and my body to the earth to be decently buried.

2^o I will and desire that all my just debts be paid;
and that all sums due me be collected for that purpose.

3^o I give and bequeath to my dear and well beloved
wife Rebecca Cheatham for and during the term of
her natural life, or during the term of her widowhood

and no longer the whole of the land plantation on
which I now live; and also the whole of my house -
hold kitchen furniture; and also two work horses
Xfarming tools accordingly; and also such parts
of my stock of Cattle and hogs as the may
need for the support of our surviving family; and
also the following slaves, to wit, George and his
wife Rose and their children John & Lydia.

4th It is my will and desire that my negro man
slave Anthony be sold; and also all such parts
of my personal estate as can be spared by
my family, which may be determined by my
widow & Executrix having due regard to the
interest of my heirs.

5th I give and bequeath to my four children Elmos, no
Cheatham, Solomon Cheatham, Betsy R. Cheatham
and Albert W. Cheatham the whole of my estate
as well real as personal of every description
to be equally divided among them. Slave & horses
alike agreeably to the provisions of law. And in
I do further give and bequeath to my son Elmos the
Cheatham my young mare Phoenix & foal. Son
Solomon Cheatham my young horse Catt Dolphin all
both of which to be accounted for at their value
on a final settlement, and also I give and bequeath
to each of my aforesaid four children a f. other bed
and furniture to be as near of equal value as
convenient. And it is further my will & desire
that each of my aforesaid children on his or her
arriving at coming of age shall be paid his or
her distribution share of whatever account may
be in the hands of my Executors a resiling from
fals and the collection of debts.

6th This my will and desire that my family all
be kept together, and that each of my above
named children may receive a suitable education.
