First I direct that my funeral expenses and all my just debts be paid as soon after my death as possible out of any money that I may die seized of may first come into the hands of my executors second I give and bequeath unto my mother Margaret Albright all my real and personal estate of every description both land and other property to be at her control and management during her natural life and third I do hereby nominate and appoint Robert Brennan sole executor of this my last will and testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 1st day of October 1849

The last will and testament of Moses Hardin Sr. of the state of Tennessee Lincoln County I Moses Hardin considering the uncertainty of this mortal life and being of sound mind and memory do make and publish this my last will and testament in manner and form following 1st I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Oprah Hardin my plantation and four negroes viz. Eddy Sarah Mandy and Harry her natural life time 2nd At the death of my wife I order that my land shall be sold and the proceeds equally divided between Salina L Carrigan wife R Hardin Moses L Hardin & Benjamin W. D. Hardin 3rd After my death I give and bequeath to my son Moses L Hardin one Negro boy Andy 4th After my death afore said I bequeath to my son Benjamin W. D. Hardin one Negro boy Tom 5th At the death of wife I give and bequeath to my son Moses L Hardin one Negro woman and child Sarah L Mandy and there in case if any 6th at the death of my wife I give and bequeath to my son Benjamin W. D. Hardin one Negro woman Eddy and her increase if any 7th I give and bequeath to Alfred W. Hardin his heirs one hundred Dollars to be equally divided at the death of wife 8th I give and bequeath to Stanford A Hardin his heirs one hundred Dollars to be divided equally at the death of my wife 9th After the death of my wife all the goods and chattels of every description to be sold and two hundred Dollars to be appropriated to the heirs of Alfred W Hardin and Stanford A Hardin and the balance if any to be equally divided between Salina L Carrigan and her heirs wife R Hardin Moses L Hardin and Benjamin W. D. Hardin 10th At the death of wife I give and bequeath to Salina L Carrigan and her heirs one Negro man named Harry in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 12th of May 1849 Moses Hardin (mark)
