Miller one dollar. I give and bequeath unto my son Thomas M. Miller one dollar. I also give and bequeath unto the wife of my son Andrew M. Miller one dollar. After the above named sums of money are paid out of my estate to my above named sons I wish my tract of land containing six acres lying & being in the County of Lincoln to be sold and the money arising from the sale thereof together with other monies debts dues or claims or property wholly whatsoever kind it may be after my decease to equally divided between my five daughters (namely) Nancy

Wright, Sarah Chitwood, Lure Grop, Martha Marshall, Polly Pinkston. I hereby appoint Jacob Wright dear my sole Executor of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all former wills by me made.
