4th and Hannah Shaw heirs of my son John J. Shaw A certain tract of land situate in the County of Lincoln Tennessee in the waters of Cold water creek the site and bounds of which is minutely described in a deed executed by Edw. Nye to me dated the 28th day of Nov 1846 & is of record in the Register's office of Lincoln County being the same tract of land on which the said John J. Shaw now lives to have and to hold the same to the above named heirs of John J. Shaw forever against the lawful claims of all persons whatever It is my will that my said son John J. Shaw remain upon the above tract of land with his family without paying rent and support them there until his youngest child to wit Hannah Shaw shall arrive at twenty one years of age at that time it is my will that my executors expose the said tract of land to public sale in a credit of one or two years & the proceeds be equally divided between my said grand children the heirs of John J. Shaw in the event my said son John J. Shaw should become disabled with being on said land & move off it before the said Hannah Shaw shall arrive at the age of twenty one years then it is my will that my executors proceed to sell the said land in the credits above mentioned and the proceeds to be applied to the support of Education of said grand children heirs of John J. Shaw so far as they extend
