

301- Last will & Testament of Thomas H. Jones

I Thomas H. Jones being of a sound mind & make and ordain this my last will
1st I give and bequeath to my mother Leah Jones my part or half of a tract of Land owned by myself and Edmund H. Jones her natural life term and at her death I give it to my Brother Edmund H. Jones.

2nd I give to my Mother Leah Jones my Cow mare

3rd I give to my Brother Edmund H. Jones my Bay Horse

4th I give to my Sister Delia H. Jones my Bay Colt

5th I want all my notes of hand as different individuals to be appropriated to the payment of the land bought by myself and Brother Edmund H. Jones

6th I want my wages for this year applied to the payment of my debts

7th I appoint Griffiths Cunningham my executor to this my last will.

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I Cornelius Sullivan being of sound & perfect mind and memory do make and published this my last will and Testament in manner and form following

1st I give and bequeath to unto my beloved wife Mary during her natural life or in and behoof my negroes viz, William Daise Connor Amos Ridge Frank and also my plantation as to all the rest of my personal Estate residue and Remainder I wish to be sold and all my debts to be paid and should there be any thing remaining I want it equally divided with all my children so as to make all equal with what I have here before given them. I hereby appoint Constant Smith my sole Executor of this my last will and Testament and hereby revoking all former wills by me made in writing whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 25 day of October 1846.
