sister Manerva ~~Ann~~ die without heirs of her body
before my said ^{and} Martha all Smith my will and
desire is that my said Aunt shall have my said
sisters share ~~also~~ and should my said ~~sister~~
Aunt Martha ~~all Smith~~ die before my said
sister and my said sister shall die without heirs
of her body as aforesaid then my will and
desire is that the whole of my estate shall go to the
legal heirs of my said Aunt Martha all Smith

Lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint my
friend J. M. G. Grog my Executor ~~of the same~~
