 furniture also such other article which I may
 have given her at her marriage until an equal
 distribution of the entire estate may become necessary
 3rd I direct that my second daughter Martha
 Ann Elisabeth when she arrives at lawful age
 marry or leaves the house of her mother shall
 have one Cow & calf one bed & clothing & furniture
 & such other articles as my eldest daughter now
 has. 4th I direct that my other daughters
 Nancy Jane Susan Caroline Polly ^{Joseph P. Chapman}
 Frances Moore when they arrive at full age or
 marry or leave their mother shall have property
 like unto the first
 5th I direct my three sons John Thomas
 Dunkin William Watson James Wiley have
 each one horse bridle & saddle to be valued
 by disinterested men

 arranged have possession of the property & charge
 of the family until the youngest child may arrive

 property be sold and an equal distribution of

 Christian Carver & John H. Sturman my lawful
