 I David S Buchanan, do make and publish this my last
 Will and testament, hereby revoking and making Void all
 other Wills by me at any time made

First I direct that my funeral expenses and all my
 debts be paid as soon after my death as possible out of any
 moneys that I may die possessed of, or may first come
 into the hands of my Executor

Secondly, I give and bequeath to my two sisters Amanda
 H. M. and Minerva A., the Red Cloths, quilts, Shirts &c which
 I received from my mother, also the Camphor Wood Wife
 Chest which I received from my brother Samuel and my Clock

Thirdly I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Nancy
 my small table Table Ware and Cooking Utensils

Fourthly I give and bequeath to Martha Edmeston my large
 pot

Fifthly I give and bequeath to John Smith, ~~the~~
 several uniforms which I received from my brother
 Samuel also my sword Cap Sash &c

Sixthly I give and bequeath to Samuel Moffatt (my nephew,
 all my Books

Seventhly I give and bequeath to William Moffatt all
 or such as he will accept of my Wearing apparel

Eighthly I give and bequeath to Alfred Smith my
 Muscannon Saddle & shot gun

Ninthly I give and bequeath to Amanda Jackson the
 large Silver Wisp Spoon which I received from my brother
 Samuel

Tenthly I give and bequeath to my two sisters Amanda
 H. M. and Minerva A. whatever portion of my father's
 estate may be coming to me from his administrator
 also whatever portion of my grandfather Robert Buchanan's
 estate may be coming to me from any heirs
 whatever, I also give and bequeath to them what ever
 amount of pay pension bounty or prize money or
 any money what ever that may be coming to me by
 reason of my brother Samuel Buchanan's services in
 the naval or marine services of the United States
 the whole as well as the bequests to them in the second
 clause to be held by them and their heirs of their
 bodies jointly and should either of my said sisters

die with out heirs of the body the survivor to have all, and
 should both die without heirs of the body then I give and
 bequeath all that I have herein given to them, to my friend
 and relative Alfred Smith

Eleventh. whatever of my property may be left after the payment of my
 debts not hereby specially bequeathed I desire to be sold and the
 proceeds paid over to my beloved wife for her use and

And lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint Alfred Smith
 my Executor I Witness whereof I do this my Will at my
 house and seal this 11th day of October 1853

 I William G. Hamilton do make and publish this my last Will and
 Testament, hereby revoking and making Void all ^{other} Wills by me at
 any time made

First I direct that my funeral expenses and all my debts
 be paid as soon after my death as possible out of any moneys
 that I may die possessed of or may first come into the hands
 of my Executor.

Secondly, I give and bequeath to my Nephew & Niece William
 Joseph Hamilton, and Mary Elizabeth Hamilton heirs of Samuel
 Hamilton, and Elizabeth, S. Plummer all of my moneys, Notes
 and accounts and personal property to be equally divided
 between the above named heirs, when the first one of them
 of age or marry, and the other part to be retained by
 my Executor till the other becomes of age or marry.
 Thirdly I direct that my saddle horse and all my furniture
 to be sold to the highest bidder on a credit of twelve
 months and that my son-in-law Pitt, be kept by my
 Executor for the use and benefit of the above named
 heirs

Fourth, I direct that my Executor take my Negro or Negroes
 in to his hands and keep them as he may think best
 for the two above named heirs as soon as I am dead
