make ordain and publish this my last
will and Testament hereby revoking and

First, I give and bequeath to my daughter

Roderrick about 60 years of age
and all other property of which

I may die possessed absolutely for her own use
if fit and to dispose of at her pleasure

I. Elias Scott of the County of Lincoln and State of Kansas
do make and publish this as my last Will and Testament hereby
revoking and making void all other Wills by me at any
time made first I direct that my funeral expenses and
all my debts be paid as soon after my death as possible
out of any money that I may ^{be} possessed of, or may
first come into the hands of my executors
Secondly, I had my beloved wife Margaret Scott during
her natural life or widowhood the plantation I now reside
on, also all my stock of horses, cattle, hogs, and sheep
and forming ~~including~~ also four negro named Ben
Peggy Lewis & Morgan, also all my household and
Kitchen furniture and all the Crop and provision
may be on hand at my death

Thirdly, I give and bequeath to my son John Scott
the plantation I now live on at the death or end of
widowhood of my wife Margaret Scott also one negro
boy named Alfred, also one horse one bid & furniture

Fourthly, I give and bequeath to my daughter Angelina
Arlette Brants one negro girl named Caroline in
cluding the mare, saddle bed and furniture that I have
hitherto given her

Sixtly I give and bequeath to my daughter Anna Scott, one Negro boy named George one horse and saddle to be worth as much as the horse and saddle that I give to Angelina Arletha Brunt one bed & furniture.

Seventhly I give and bequeath to my son John Scott my daughter Arletha Brunt & Anna Scott one sideboard Cupboard and bureau at the death of my wife to be equally divided amongst them and the one taken the sideboard shall pay the other two seven dollars each.

Seventhly I give and bequeath to my grandson Eli McGee and my grand daughter Rosanna McGee being the living heirs of my daughter Anna McGee the sum of five ~~years~~ each it being the balance of the portion I intend her.

Eighthly I give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth tench five dollars.

Ninthly I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Scott one bed and furniture at the death of my wife Margaret Scott.

Tenthly my will and desire that after the death of my wife that my daughter Anna Scott shall have twenty five dollars out of the value of the four Negros that is to say Black Peggy Lewis and Morgan and then to be equally divided between my son John Scott my Daughters Angelina Arletha Brunt and Anna Scott according to valuation.

Eleventhly I give and bequeath to my daughters Mary Scott, Sarah Wilson, Nancy Lynch, Angelina Arletha Brunt, and Anna Scott, and my son John Scott all manner after the death of my wife Margaret Scott dividing of stock of all kinds, forming tools, house hold and Kitchinfurniture still, & tubs to be sold & divided equally among them.

I do hereby nominate and appoint Andrew Lewis of Marshall County Tenn. my executor to this my last will and Testament. In witness whereof I do to this my will set my hand & seal this day of 1843.

Jacob Hamilton's Last Will

Tennessee Lincoln County. In the name of God amen I Jacob Hamilton of the County and State aforesd knowing that it appointed unto man once to die, being weak in body but of sound mind, do make this my last will in words, manner and form, to wit: First of all I give my soul to God who gave it, to me and my body to my Executors, (whom I shall herein after appoint,) to be buried in a Christian like manner. And as touching such worldly goods as it hath pleased God to bless me with, I will & bequeath in the following manner.

Item 1st my will and desire is that my just and lawful debts should be paid out of my estate.

Item 2^d my will and desire is that my wife Elizabeth Hamil-ton shall have my tract of land, where I now live containing four hundred & fifteen acres, be the same more or less with all my house hold & Kitchen furniture farming utensils as much stock of every description, that I am possessed of as may be sufficient for her and her family and further she is to have choice of two of my negroes, all which is to have during her natural life or widow hood, then it is to return to the estate and be sold on twelve months credit and divided among my children so as to make them all equal, and my wife provided she should marry, further my will and desire is that my wife have all the money and effects which may come from her fathers estate to dispose off as she pleases.

Item 3^o I give and bequeath to my son Eddley Hammon one hundred acres of land more or less, estimated at five hundred dollars, which is to be rendered in upon a division of my estate.

Item 4th I will & bequeath to my son Jasper J. Hammon one hundred acres of land more or less which he has in possession estimated at five hundred dollars, which is to be rendered in upon a division of my estate.

Item 5th I will and bequeath to my son Ezekiel Welson Hamilton one hundred acres of land more or less which he has in possession estimated at five hundred dollars which is to be rendered in upon a division of my estate.
