

Last Will and Testament of Elisha Bagley d.^{r.}
I Elisha Bagley of Lincoln County State of Minnesota do make
and this as my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all
former and similar instruments heretofore made & published by me
herein. It is my will and desire that my body be buried in a decent
and plain manner, and that my funeral expenses and all my just
debts be paid out of the first money which may come into the
hands of my Executor hereinafter appointed.

Item 2^o I Will and bequeath to my beloved wife Elizabeth, the house and
lot in the town of Hayfield which I recently purchased of Mrs
Grauer, being the house and lot where George Grant now lives; should
my said wife die before me the said house and lot to fall back
to my estate, but should my said wife survive me, then she is to
have and hold the said house and lot in her own absolute right to
dispossession of the same as she may think proper.

Item 3^o I Will and bequeath to my said wife Elizabeth the following
slaves during her natural life viz; Lucy, Maria, Noah and
Jane, and after her death the said slaves to fall back into the
hands of my Executor to be distributed as hereinafter provided.

Item 4^o I Will and bequeath to my said wife Elizabeth all my
household and kitchen furniture and two cows and calves to disposed
of the same as she may desire.

Item 5^o I Will and bequeath to my said wife Elizabeth during her
natural life, provided she survive me, interest on the sum of three
thousand dollars, and I hereby direct that my executor keep back
one fourth part of the same during the natural life of my said wife and
pay to her the annual interest on the same, and after her death to
distribute the same to my legatees hereinafter named in the proportion
I direct for the distribution of my estate among said legatees.

Item 6^o I Will and bequeath to the heirs of the body of my deceased daughter
Elizabeth C. Hill one fifth of my Real and personal property.

Item 7^o I Will and bequeath to Martha Bagley wife of my son John
R. Bagley during her natural life one fifth of my Real & personal
property to her sole and separate use and after death, I will and desire
that said property be equally divided between the children of my son
John R and the said Martha.

Item 8^o I Will and bequeath to Eliza B. Bagley wife of my son Robert
H. C. Bagley during her natural life one fifth of my Real & personal
property to her sole and separate use said portion subject nevertheless in
the first instance to a deduction of four hundred and forty dollars,
and forty three cents the amount of a note given to me by C. M. Ringo

Grandson for Mr. H. C. Field for my said son R. H. C. Bagley and after death
I will and desire that said property be equally divided between the
children of my said son R. H. C. Bagley and Eliza B.

Item 9^o I Will and bequeath to the children of my deceased daughter Barbara
A. Hall one fifth of my Real and personal property.

Item 10^o I Will and bequeath to the children of my deceased daughter Eliza H. Morris one
fifth of my Real and personal property.

Item 11^o I Will and bequeath to my Negro woman Lucy survival me and my wife it is my will
and desire that my executor take her into his possession and retain in his
hands of my money so sufficient amount to support the said Lucy
during her natural life - the said Lucy is not to be hired out, but my
executor shall see that she labors, long as she can for her own support
and only in such amount as is necessary above her own earnings for
her support. Item 12^o I Will and direct to my executor hereinafter
appointed to provide to sell at public sale as soon after my death as
practicable the tract of land on which I now live on a credit of one
ten and three years and divide the proceeds among my legatees as herein
before provided. Item 13^o I Will and direct my Executor to sell to
the highest bidder the slave Maria, Jane and Noah and their issues
so soon after my death of my wife as practicable, and should remain
my said wife and be proprie of said slaves or any other slaves in
my death, then I desire my Executor to dispose of the same to the highest
bidder and divide the proceeds among my legatees as hereinbefore provided.

Item 14^o I hereby nominate and appoint Caleb Ringo Executor of this my last
Will and Testament. In testifying whereof I have unto set my hand and
affid my seal this the 29th day of November 1855 of the body "intended"
before signed
