 and five head of Hogs her choice all my Sheep to be her own
 2nd I bequeath to my Daughter Mary M. Davis 1 Bed & furniture one
 side Saddle one Sowl Mare
 3rd I will to my Daughter Abner R. Davis 1 Bed and furniture and
 one side Saddle
 4th I will to my Son Samuel D. Davis Bay Horse and Saddle
 5th I will to my Daughter Hannah B. Davis 1 Bed and furniture and
 one side Saddle worth \$18.00 or the equivalent
 6th I will to my Son Henry B. one Clay Bank Mare and Saddle
 7th I will to my other 3 Daughters namely Katharine D. Sarah A. M.
 and Lucinda Jane Davis one bed and furniture each
 8th All the rest of my property I will to my Wife K. M. during her
 life time or widow hood, at the termination of either I will my
 land to be equally divided between my Sons Crates B. Saml D.
 and Henry B. and that ^{they} support my Mother her life time, and
 also that all my Daughters have their boarding off the farm
 during the time they live single or live on the farm and
 that my ^{sons} bear an equal proportion of their boarding
 9th I will that all my other property be equally divided among
 all my above named Children. I wish my wife to be my
 Administrator let each one of my Sons choose a person
 to divide the land for him. Now my Children I have
