Smith and Sally Ann Braggs & one share to Rufus
H Smith & Frances E Jones Jointly

Item 3 I give to my Brother W T Rhea my negro
man named Manuel to be taken at Valuation
and should said boy be Valued to more than
an equal share my sole Brother to pay off
overplus & keep him

51 Last Will & Testament of James Lison


I James Lison do make and publish this as my
last Will and Testament, hereby revoking and making
void all other Wills by me at any time made
First, I direct that my funeral expenses and debts be paid
as soon after my death as possible, out of any money
I may die possessed of, or that may first come into the
hands of my Executor

Second I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Rebecca
all my Estate both real and personal, during her natural
life, or widowhood, to enable her to raise and educate
our children, and at her death, I direct that the personal
property that may be on hand, to be sold on a credit
of twelve months and that my land be sold on a credit
of One, two, and three years in equal installments and
the proceeds equally divided between all my children,
to wit, Sarah Ann, Catherine C. Jones, L. James Jr., Mary
M., Martha R., George, H. D., Margaret E., Susan A., and
Parthenia C. Lison and

Thirdly in case my wife should marry again I direct
that my land and personal property be sold in the
same manner as above directed, in case of her death,
but the proceeds of such sale in case of her marriage
shall be equally divided between all my children and
my wife Rebecca, and

Fourth I hereby nominate and appoint Christopher
Corrigan my Executor in testimony of which
I do to this my Will set my hand and seal the
28th day of April 1852
