1st To my wife Margaret the plantation on which I now
live during her life or widow hood and at her
Death to my son James Marks I also give her my
some mare and one cow and calf and all my
house hold and Kitchen furniture

2nd To my son-in-law John Hinman and his wife
Sarah I give and bequeath as follows to wit
my land beginning where my east boundary line
crosses the creek thence down the creek with its
meanderings to where a hollow west of said Hin-
mans house come in thence south with the hollow
to my south boundary line thence East with same
to a poplar my corner thence North to the Creek
the begining -

3rd To my son-in-law James Henderson and his wife Mary
I give as follows to wit beginning on my North
East corner next said Hinman House running
South boundary line of yds marks tract there
met 6 poles to a stake just east said marks
corner thence south so far as by running

west to the Harpoe east boundary line will make one
hundred and twenty acres.

4th To my son James & his the balance of my lands
and the half of what hogs we may have at any
Decades also my farming tools and the balance
of my property after paying my best debts
to be sold or divided between them and I
hereby declare this to be my last will and testa-
ment in which I have hereunto set my hand
and seal Elizm 18th 1848.

the uncertainty of life and the certainty of death
do make and publish this and no other to be my
last will and testament hereby making void all
other wills by me at any time made

First I give and bequeath my soul to god who gave it
Second I direct that my body be buried in a decent
manner having regard to my manner of life heretofore
Third I direct that my funeral expenses and all of my
debts be paid out of any money that I may die possessed
of or that may first come in to the hands of my
executor and in case there should not be sufficient
money or claims for that purpose then my executor
executor or executors may sell sufficiency of my
~~belonging~~ property for that purpose

Fourth I give and bequeath to each my five daughters
a negro girl as follows to wit my negro girl Anna
to Caroline Jane I give my negro girl Amanda to
Lotta Mariana I give my negro girl Caroline to Lucia

Carr, I give my negro girl Angelina which I direct
they shall have said negro at my death provided
provided that they have not already received the
fifth after my best debts and legal liabilities are

and the distribution as directed in the fourth article was
made which distribution was made to my said five
daughters during their natural lives and then to their
widely heirs after them them and to no other.

I give and bequeath unto my wife Charlotte all my real
estate my negro slaves and all of my personal prop-
erty of whatever kind it may be with all my cash notes
and other claims to her and to hold during her
natural life or widowhood and in case she should
intermarry with another man I direct that all of
my property be equally divided between her and
her thirteen children to wit McCajah Rebeck the
Hir. of Allen Broadway James Walker David Emmett
Samuel William Frederick Robert Isaac Martin Sasha
Delund sarah Eveline Elisira Jem Charlotte Eliza
Pearl Zerina Julia Malissa Laura to each
a fourteenth part of my Estate but in the case
of the death of my said wife Charlotte I direct my
Estate be equally divided between my thirteen
children giving to each a thirteenth part of my
Estate provided that my five daughters are not
to account to the Estates in any way for the
distributions made to them in the fourth article
of this will

I hereby nominate my beloved wife Charlotte
to be the sole executrix to this my last will and
testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand by name and affixed my seal this the
16th day of April in the year of our Lord 1837

of his labour during his natural life and also
to the heirs of his natural body if any and
if more to be equally divided between his
brothers and sisters.

Item 6. I leave to my Grand daughter Susan Head
Stephenson one negro boy Willis with the benefit
of his labour during her natural life and at her
death to go to the heirs of her natural body

Item 7. I leave to my Grand daughter Sarah Head
during my negro boy Peter and her in-
crease during her natural life and at her
death to go to the heirs of her natural body
if any and if more to her Brothers and
sisters.
