Of the Last Will and Testament of Judge Dunkin
October the 15th 1834

I Judge Dunkin do make and publish
this as my last will and testament hereby revoking
and making void all other wills by me at any
time made 1st I direct that my legal debts
be paid as soon after my death as possible out of
any money I may die possessed of or may first
come into the hands of my executor
2nd I direct that my wife Susan during her life
or widowhood shall have all the property both
personal and real after my legal debts are
discharged 3rd I direct my eldest daughter
Rebecca now Rebecca Bathum have and keep
the property she now holds in her possession
which being one Cow & calf one bed and clothing and
furniture also such other article which I may
have given her at her marriage untill an equal
distribution of the entire estate may become necessary
4th I direct that my second daughter Martha
Ann Elisabeth when she arrives at lawful age
marry or leaves the house of her mother shall
have one Cow & calf one bed & clothing & furniture
& such other articles as my eldest daughter now
has 5th I direct that my other daughters
Nancy Jane Susan Caroline Polly ^{Sarah P. Chapman} ~~Constance~~
Frances Moore when they arrive at full age or
marry or leave their mother shall have property
like unto the first
6th I direct my three sons John Thomas
Dunkin William Watson James Wiley have
each one horse bridle & saddle to be valued
by disinterested men

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I further direct that at the death of my wife Susan
that the oldest heirs then living if it can be suitably
arranged have possession of the property & charge
of the family untill the youngest child may arrive
at lawful age if not my desire is that my
property be sold and an equal distribution of
the proceeds of the sale be made between my
heirs 8th I direct I appoint and direct
Christian Barger & John H. Sturman my lawful
Executors In witness whereof I do to this my
last will and testament set my hand and
seal this October 15th 1834 Judge ^{his} Dunkin
Witnesseth
