

Last Will and testament of Mary A. Green B.
I Mary Ann Green being of sound mind and
being desirous to arrange my worldly affairs
in view of my approaching dissolution do ordain
and publish the following as my last will and
testament

First I desire to be decently buried and a suitable
monument placed over my remains

I want all my debts paid It is my will that
my son John Jacob Green shall have my land
at twenty Dollars per acre payable in three equal
annual instalments

I Give my soup spoon to Julia Evans

I Give my new table spoons to my daughter
Eliza

I Give one ~~new~~ set tea spoons and my set of
china to my grand daughter Mary M. Gillespie
The bureau which sets in my room and velvet
mantle I Give to my daughter Eliza

My mantle glass I Give to my daughter Jane
My Old table spoons and balance of Tea and
Cream spoons I Give to my son John J. Green

My Breast-plate with George's likeness I Give to
Eliza my other breast-plate to Mary M. Gillespie

I Give Three hundred Dollars to Mary Ann McGowan
to be placed in the hands of a Trustee and
kept an interest until she arrives at the age
of twenty one years The Note I hold on Jefferson
Greene's estate with the interest thereon I Give to his
daughter Kate Green when she arrives at the age of
twenty one years and if she should die before that
without issue the whole of said Amount to be divided
equally between my Children then living and the
heirs of such as may be dead The principle of said
Note is five hundred dollars which is all I intend for
my said Grand daughter Kate Green to have out of
my estate

The large looking glass in my room I Give to my
daughter Eliza McGowan

My Gold Spectacles given me by my daughter ^{Margaret} R. Carmack
I Give to my son Joseph

It is my Will that all my Negroes should be sold
they & her Children to be sold together Giving to Eliza McGowan
the preference in buying them at a fair valuation
I Give one bedstead and furniture to John Jacob Green
the one that sets in his room

I want all the balance of my property and effects not herein
specified sold and the sum of my ^{estate} after deducting
special legacies, be equally divided between my children
and the heirs of such as may be dead the children of Margaret

R. Carmack and Catharine Gillespie receiving the amount
their Mother would be entitled to excepting my grand daughter

Kate Green who has been above provided for
The amount whether in money or negroes which may
be going to Eliza McGowan is, and specially ^{what} ~~intended~~ ^{for} ~~for~~
and her Children and as such I request A. A. Green
to act as trustee in this behalf also to take charge of
the money given to Mary Ann McGowan

I nominate and appoint A. A. & J. J. Green Executors
of this my last Will and Testament In witness
whereof I do to this my will set my hand and seal
this the 27th Decr 1857 Mary Ann Green

of the Testator this the 27th Decr 1857
