 utensils be sold together with all my household and kitchen furni-
 ture - I wish my Executor to advertise and sell the land in one
 ten and three year time and he is hereby fully empowered to
 give a good and lawful title to the same; The other property and
 is credit of twelve months. - I wish to be decently interred and
 I wish all my just debts settled together with my funeral expenses
 and after this I bequeath unto my beloved daughter Mary
 Pigg the sum of One Hundred Dollars; also to my daughter
 Eliza my son Thomas W. and my daughter Jennie it is my
 request that the three last named have the balance to be divided
 into three equal shares; and I do hereby constitute and appoint
 Benjamin H. Clark my Executor to this Will and put in him
 full power to sell and collect and pay on the same as directed
 by law, as witness I have hereunto set my hand and affixed
 my seal this 21st day of August 1858
