Leon my household.

5th I give and bequeath to Margaret Greenshaw
widow of Pascal Greenshaw one feather bed & quilt
and shawl.

6th I give & bequeath to my Niece Nancy E.
Haarbauck all the ballance of my property of
every description together with what monies I may
have on hands at the time of my decease
after paying all just debts & expenses.
