

1. Nancy Stephens being weak in body but sound in mind and memory do make publick this my last will and testament make nul and void all other wills made by me at any other time.

1st I give and bequeath to my Brother Leon Wells my Negro Woman Charlitt.

2nd I give and bequeath to my Brother William Wells one hundred dollars which is now in the hands of Francis Wells and which is a portion of my Father's estate which is due me.

3rd I give and bequeath to my Brother Francis Wells the ballance that is due me of my Father's estate & twenty dollars that my Mother owes me.

4th I give & bequeath to Mary Leon Widow of William Leon my ballance.

5th I give and bequeath to Margaret Crenshaw widow of Pascal Crenshaw one feather bed & quilt and shawl.

6th I give & bequeath to my Niece Nancy E. Fairbanks all the ballance of my property of every description together with what moneys I may have on hands at the time of my decease after paying all just debts & expenses.
