sold to the best advantage and the money to be equally
divided among all our children I also leave my wife
& William Spencer executors of Said estate and to pay off
all my debts and to collect all that is owing and should
then remove stocks then she could support self of at
all times when there is too much for her to support
my wish is that my wife should be well supported
out Said estate as long as she lives this my last
will and Testament

daughter Mary G. Hearalson all my houses and barns
work ovens all my hogs and sheep all my plantation
tools one waggon House hold and Kitchen furniture
also four beds and bed close all of the crop all my
geese I have hearkunto set my hand and Seal the twenty
first day of October in the year of our Lord one
Thousand eight hundred and fifty two
